
Download How Do I Know When It's Time to Euthanize My Dog? Online Book PDF by Hope Morgan

How do you know when it's time? Should you let your dog die naturally or have it euthanized? Should they die at home or at the vet's office? What would warrant having your dog put to sleep? Is it different for different dogs? How do you decide? What if you don't want to decide? What if you do it too early? What if you wait too long? What questions should you be asking your vet? What questions should you be asking yourself? What is the death process like and what should you expect? What should you do with the dead dog's body? How do you move on? How do you cope with ANY of this?

Hope knows that death and dying are pretty complex issues, but one fundamental tenet never changes...

Death is inevitable. Regret is not.

Make sure you do the right thing. Your dog is depending on you. Don't blow it.
